
Talons of Power: Wings of Fire Book 9

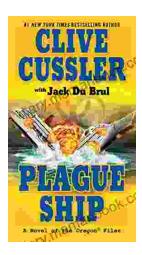
